## In The Box!

This is a game to help your child to learn the initial sounds of the letters of the alphabet,

### To make:

Print out the two baseboards, on card if you can. If not, on paper.

Print out the picture cards and cut them out along the lines.

### To play:

You will need a small box, or other such container.

Each player takes a baseboard, red or blue. The picture cards are then placed in the box, face down (they can be piled up).

Each player takes it in turns to take a picture card and place it in the correct position on their board. If they already have a picture on that letter, then the picture is replaced into the box with the cry 'In the box!'.

Play continues until all the picture cards are taken. The winner is the first to fill their board.

Do: Emphasise the initial sound of each word.



Say: 'What does (the picture) begin with?'
