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Match it!

This game can be played at two levels. First of all to help the child learn the initial sounds, then once these are grasped, to learn to blend three letter words with a short vowel sound. If you are teaching a child who has learnt to guess, then use the letter/word cards as a base board and cut out the pictures.

How to make:

Print out the baseboards you require, pictures, words or letters.

Then print out and cut up the cards you need to match your baseboards. i.e. If you want the picture baseboards, then choose either letters or words to cut up to match the pictures. If you want the word or letter baseboards, then cut up the pictures to match.

How to play:

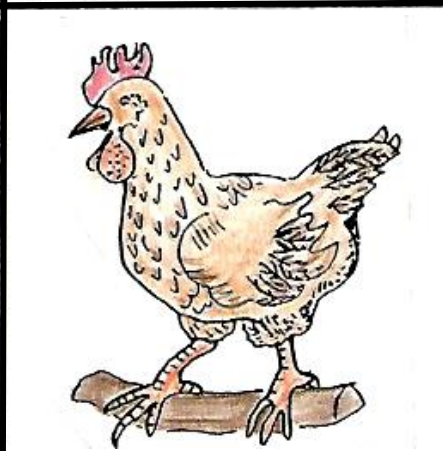
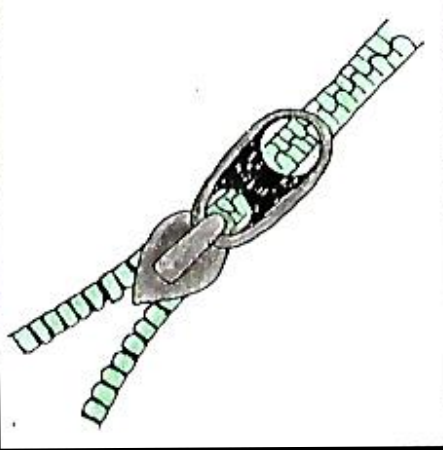
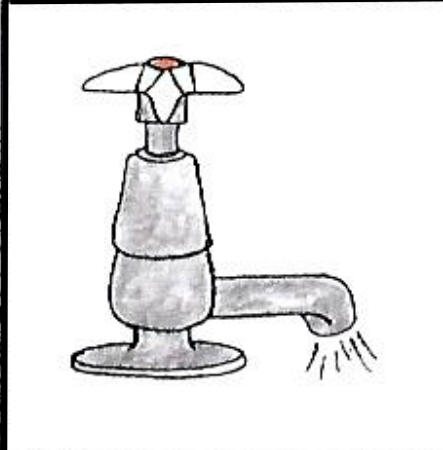
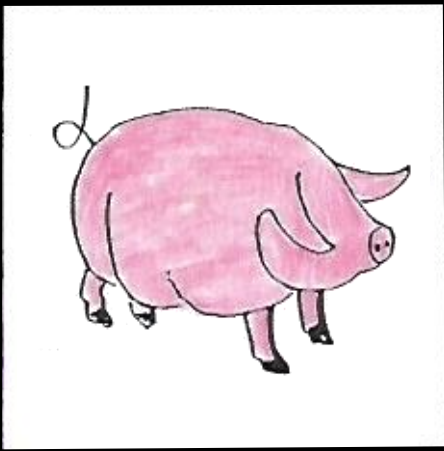
Each player has a base board. The individual cards are scattered on the table. Each player takes it in turns to pick up a card and see if they can match it to a picture on their card.

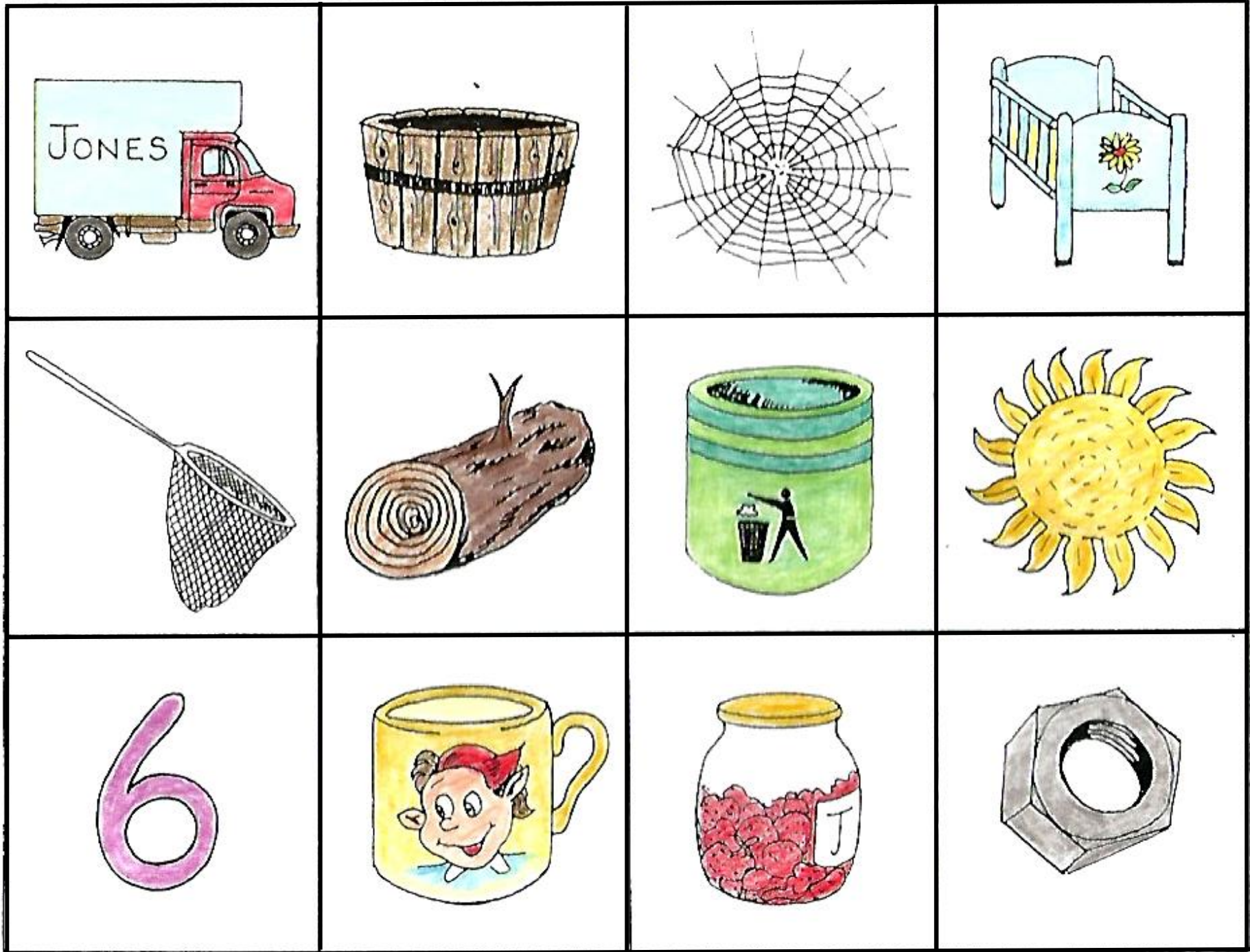
Do encourage lots of sounding out. Let them help you! The more sounding out the better!
