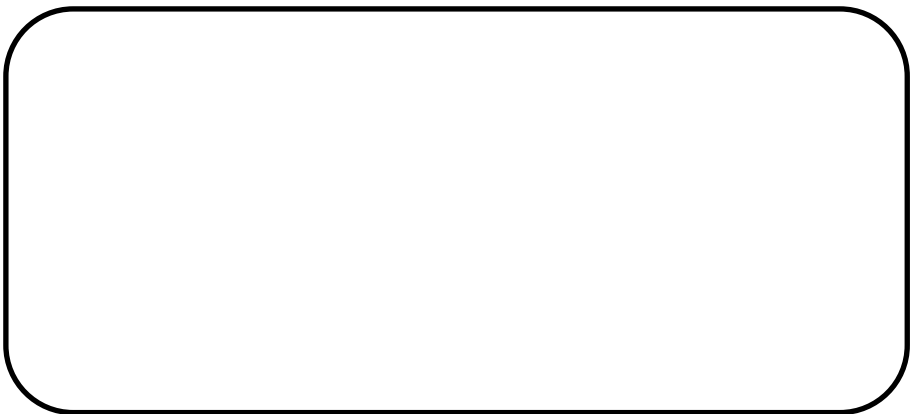


Underline the sound 'oa' in red. Read and draw.

I must not moan he thinks to himself. We need the rain. Tom eats his toast and when he looks again, it is not raining. I can go boating!" he says.



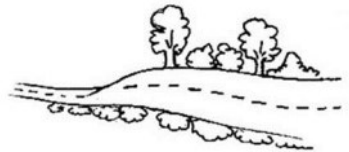
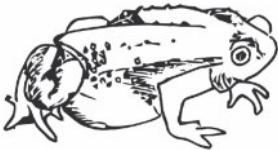
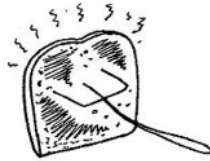
